In observance of the death anniversary of M.K. Gandhi, January 30, 1948, Professor Nandini Iyer delivered a lecture at the Faulkner Gallery, Santa Barbara Public Library, on January 30, 2007. His fearless path forged the future for India, and indeed for the world. She assisted her husband, Professor Raghavan Iyer, in preparing his book, "The Moral and Political Thought of Mahatma Gandhi".
